Misumu Bay Wetplay

This interactive water adventure area lets children GET WET & GO WILD!! during their day “On Safari!™”. Navigating refreshing sprays, spouts and geysers - Misumu Bay Wetplay - provides plenty of play for both young and the young at heart.

General Rules and Regulations

1. All guests must follow the direction of African Lion Safari staff.
2. All children that are not completely toilet trained must wear swim diapers. Regular diapers are not permitted in the water.
3. Children must be supervised by parent/guardian at all times.
4. No Running.
5. Rough play or actions that are hazardous or disruptive are not permitted.
6. No swinging on the pull ropes for the shower sprayers.
7. Food, glass containers, or beverages are not permitted in the water or in the area immediately surrounding the pools.
8. No gum chewing.
9. Smoking is not permitted.
10. Shoes are not permitted in the water.
11. Lockers are available. African Lion Safari is not responsible for lost or stolen articles.
12. All guests must comply with **Park Conditions of Entry (See Programme and Map)**
13. Guests who engage in waterpark activities offered by the park, do so solely at their own risk.

Hygiene Rules

1. Do not enter the pools if you have an open sore, rash, or are experiencing nausea, vomiting or diarrhea.
2. Department of Public Health recommends that visitors have a change of clothing for splash pad activities.
3. Recreational water is not intended for drinking.

Attraction Closure

1. **Fouling of Pools**
We recommend that children use the washroom facilities frequently to prevent fouling of the pools. Should this occur, pools will be closed temporarily.
2. **Inclement Weather**
Misumu Bay Wetplay may close temporarily during severe weather conditions. As soon as conditions permit safe operation these features will re-open. No refunds or rainchecks due to inclement weather.

African Lion Safari®

Misumu Bay Wetplay is open to all guests to enjoy, however to ensure your children's safety, some restrictions apply.

Fish Tipping Bucket

Height Restrictions (Children will receive an official height measurement)

1. Children must be 96.5 cm (38 inches) or taller to go up on the structure. Children must be wearing a wrist band.
2. Children under 96.5 cm (38 inches) are not permitted on the tipping bucket structure. They must be held in parents/guardians arms while in the pool.
3. Adults are permitted in the pool but not up on the structure.
4. Do not sit or lay down under tipping buckets.

Kids' Slides

1. Obey all instructions given by attendant.
2. Children under 96.5 cm (38 inches) are not permitted on the slides.
3. Maximum weight: 1 person, 91 kg (200lbs)
4. Only one child at a time. No bunching, chaining or double riders permitted.
5. When using the slides, children must go down feet first, face up and keep all body parts within the confines of the slides.
6. Do not run, dive, stand, kneel, rotate or stop in the slides.
7. Riders must wait for the attendants start signal before going down the slide.
8. Food, glass, bottles, or beverages are not permitted in the water slide area.
9. Adults are not permitted on slides
10. Children must be supervised by parent/guardian at all times.

Butterfly/Toddler Area

This area is intended for toddlers 5 years and under.
